In reviewing our file on the captioned entity, we find that we have requested registration as a charitable trust, pursuant to Act 101, Public Acts of 1961, as last amended, the Supervision of Trustees for Charitable Purposes Act, on two separate occasions.

Under said Act 101, the Attorney General has the power to issue an order similar to a subpoena requiring any trustee to give information under oath and to produce books, memoranda, papers, and other pertinent documents. We do not like to issue such an order, but have no alternative in those situations where a charitable trustee refuses to follow the statutory requirements of Act 101.

We expect to receive the completed registration forms and other documents without further unexplained delay.
