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THE RIGA DOME BOYS CHOIR.

The Riga Dome Boys Choir, the premier boys choir of Latvia, tours the world bringing Latvian music and culture to the forefront of the international music scene.

The Choir was formed in 1990 as freedom began to stir in Latvia and Soviet rule was crumbling. The Dome, Riga's majestic cathedral, was changed from a concert hall back to a house of worship and became the home of the Choir.


The Choir began to master the vast repertoire of music which had historically been performed in churches, but had been unavailable under Soviet rule. Its repertoire today ranges from early church music to Monteverdi, Bach, Mozart to favorite 20th century composer, Benjamin Britten. The Choir excels in singing Latvian folk songs and many contemporary Latvian composers have dedicated their works to it.



The accomplished singers of the Choir come from the Darzins Boys Choir, which has thrilled audiences since 1950. From 1963 - 87 the Darzins Boys toured extensively throughout the Soviet Union and brought Latvian culture to the other republics. Since 1988, the Choir has performed in many European countries. The Choir's 1995 tour of North America represents its second appearance in the US and Canada (the first tour was in 1992).

The members of the Choir attend the prestigious Emils Darzins Music School of Riga, where they receive a comprehensive education with emphasis on music. After many years of voice training the young singers audition for a place in the Choir. Each boy is a professional who can sing before any audience. Many graduates are leading professional musicians in Latvia as well as other countries.

At home in Riga, the Choir performs at many services in the Dome and presents Easter and Christmas concerts. Yearly subscription concerts take place with the Philharmonic Orchestra. It also performs at benefit concerts, regularly tours Latvia and hosts visiting choirs. The Choir will host the Second International Boys Choir Festival in Riga in April, 1995.

RIGA DOME BOYS CHOIR

The Riga Dome Boys Choir was founded in 1950 and over the years became renowned throughout the former Soviet Union. Since 1987 the Choir has had an enthusiastic following in Europe. In 1990, the Choir became affiliated with the Riga Dome Cathedral, where it sings liturgy at worship services. The young choristers attend the newly established Riga Dome Choir School, where they receive an intensive music, as well as academic education. The Choir performs with the Latvian National Symphony Orchestra, taking part in opera productions and concerts. Every five years, the Choir hosts an International Boys Choir Festival in Riga. The Riga Dome Boys Choir has performed in Belgium, Canada, Denmark, France, Germnay, Holland, Luxembourg, Norway, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland and the United States. Following its 1995 U.S. concert tour, the Choir will be performing in Japan.

JĀNIS ERENŠTREITS

Jānis Erenštreits recently celebrated 25 years as the director of the Riga Dome Boys Choir. He has toured extensively with the Choir through the former republics of the Soviet Union, Europe and the United States and Canada. He has organized choral conferences and festivals in Latvia attracting choirs from around the world. Presently, he is the director of the Riga Dome Choir School.

AIVARS KALĒJS

Aivars Kalējs is organist at both Riga New St. Gertrude's Church and at the Riga Dome Cathedral. He has performed in the Baltic countries, Russia, Europe and the U.S. and participated in many organ festivals, including the International Organ Festival in Methuen near Boston and the Jean Alain Organ Music Conference in Ann Arbor, Michigan. He has made six solo records of organ music.



PROGRAM NOTES

GABRIEL FAURE, the French composer, was also a teacher, organist and pianist. Assistant organist at Notre Dame, Paris and close friend of Saint-Saens, he began to gain fame after the age of 50. While living in Rennes, he wrote his first church music, including the motet *TU ES PETRUS*.

JOHANN CHRISTOF FRIEDRICH BACH was the eldest son of Johann Sebastian Bach. On many occasions he collaborated with Johann Herder setting his poetry to music and creating cantatas, oratorios and other dramatic works. His choral compositions, including *GLORIA* from WACHET AUF, RUFT UNS DIE STIMME, are lyrical and imaginative in style.


WOLFGANG AMADEUS MOZART, composed many complete masses, yet some of his compositions, such as *KYRIE IN D* (*KV 90*), remained as only part of a mass.

BENJAMIN BRITTEN, composed a wide range of modern vocal music. *TE DEUM IN C MAJOR* is one of his few sacred compositions.

JOSEPH RHEINBERGER, born in Vaduz, Lichtenstein, was a composer, organist, teacher, and pianist who made a significant contribution to sacred music. DEXTERA DOMINI, GOTTES GEWALTGER ARM is from FIVE HYMNS, OPUS 140, NO. 2.

ARNE MELLNAS is a Swedish composer who studied in Berlin, Paris and Vienna. He is known for experimenting with new sounds, and introducing theatrical elements in his compositions.




